Throughout Scripture we have the example of planned, intentional worship. The many festivals and feasts that are recorded in the Old Testament are intentional acts of worship to retell the story of God in the lives of the people of Israel. Paul reminds the people of Corinth to keep corporate worship services orderly (1Corinthians 14).

There is a misconception in some contemporary settings, that planned worship pushes out the work of the Holy Spirit. We believe that the Holy Spirit is fully active in the planning process and will guide us in leaving room for the unexpected.
